

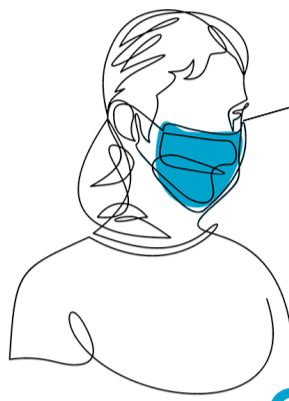
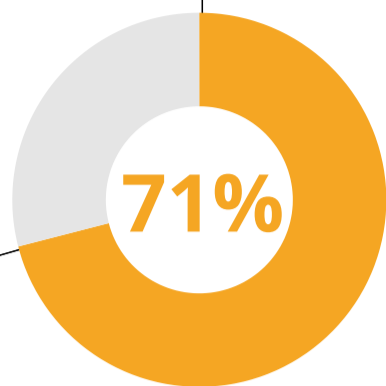
What Inspires Hope?

71% of Canadians don't think that taking action on climate change is a waste of time and resources

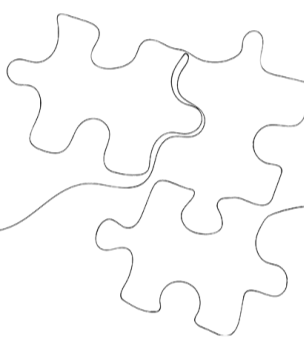


Lessons from COVID-19 have influenced perspectives and increased awareness

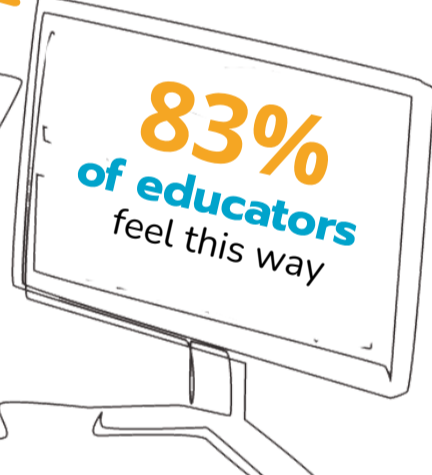
68% of Canadians agree the pandemic has helped them to recognize the importance of science to provide society with essential facts & evidence-based knowledge



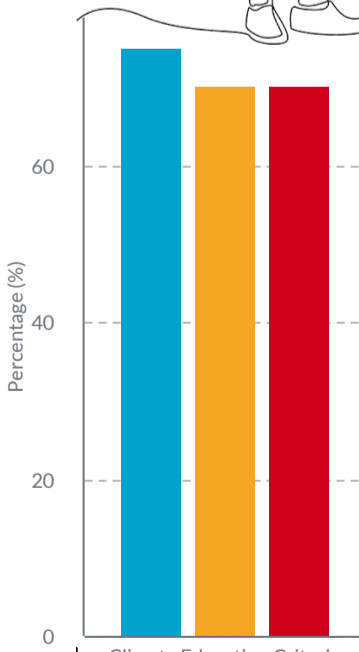
74% realize that no matter where we are in the world, we are all interconnected



In the next few years, **72% of Canadians** would be willing to change 'some' or 'a lot' in their life (at school, work or home) to help reduce the effects of climate change



62% of Canadians feel better about climate change when they are taking actions to reduce their own carbon footprint



When teaching climate education in schools, most Canadians agree that **climate change education should aim to change the way people behave (75%)**, and **include how to take personal action (70%)**, as well as **how to take collective action in the school and community (70%)**

69% of Canadians feel that the work and voices of young people can inspire important climate action
